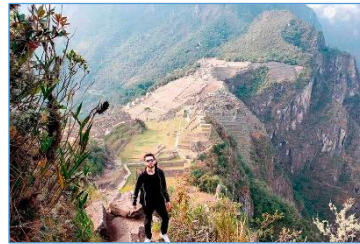

Some of the little known destinations worth visiting are: the mountain of Palcoyo, the South Valley of Cusco, the fortress of Waqrapukara, the Tres Cruces de Oro viewpoint, the abode of the gods, the thermal baths of Cocalmayo and more. SUMMARY

The Machu Picchu Full Day tour is the service that most tourists choose to visit the wonder of the world. It can be done any day of the year. However, it is best to do it from April to December. In January, February or March the rains can prevent you from getting that dream photo with Machupicchu in the background. Although on those days the sun can also shine splendidly. In any case, visiting with a tour allows you to enjoy the Inca city without worrying about queues or additional travel expenses. Although it is also possible to visit Machu Picchu on your own (acquiring each of the tickets and services), going with a tour is the freest and safest way to get to know the wonder of the Incas.

The tour to Machu Picchu involves a detailed organization. The reason? The Inca city is about 100 kilometers from the city of Cusco. That is why it is required: transfer to the train station, train ticket and bus tickets. All these transportation services are already included in the tour. In addition to Machu Picchu in the tour you will visit the town of Aguas Calientes and the beautiful villages of the Sacred Valley through the train ride. The service lasts 16 hours (from 4 am to 8 pm). It includes full transportation, entrance to Machu Picchu and professional tour guide service.

MACHU PICCHU FULL DAY TOUR - DETAILED ITINERARY



ITINERARY

Pick up from the hotel

The tour begins with the pick up from the tourist's hotel in the city of Cusco at an average of 4 am.

Transfer to the train station

On board a modern minivan tourists will travel from the city of Cusco to the train station of Ollantaytambo in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. This journey takes approximately 1 hour 45 minutes.

Train ride to Aguas Calientes

On board the Expedition train, tourists will travel through beautiful Andean landscapes towards the town of Aguas Calientes. This journey takes 1 hour 40 minutes on average. The train offers a pleasant trip surrounded by beautiful landscapes of the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

Final bus ride to Machu Picchu

In the town of Aguas Calientes, a person will accompany you to the bus station where you must board the ecological service that leads to Machu Picchu. The journey is short. It takes only 30 minutes.

Entrance and visit to Machu Picchu

The entrance to Machu Picchu will be accompanied by a professional tour guide. The tour of the archaeological site takes approximately 2 hours. During the visit you will be able to take the classic postcard photo that everyone dreams of. You will also appreciate the main temples and constructions.

Return to Aguas Calientes

At the end of the visit to Machu Picchu, it is time to return by bus to Aguas Calientes. In this town you will have free time to have lunch (not included in the tour). If you contracted the special lunch, you will enjoy a delicious menu at the Tinkuy restaurant (belonging to the 5-star Sanctuary Lodge hotel).

Return to Cusco by train and minivan

At the time indicated by the tour guide, you will board the Expedition train that will take you back to the town of Ollantaytambo. There you will board the minivan to the city of Cusco. The tour ends at about 8:00 pm in a central square of the city of Cusco.

TOUR MACHU PICCHU FULL DAY – THE TOURIST SERVICES INCLUDED

PICK UP AND TRANSPORTATION TO THE OLLANTAYTAMBO TRAIN STATION

The tour includes picking up the tourist at his hotel located in the historic center of the city of Cusco (the vast majority of tourist hotels are there). If your hotel is far from this area, you must coordinate a central city square for your pick-up. You will then travel by tourist minivan to the Ollantaytambo train station. Transportation is spacious, clean and comfortable. It allows a pleasant journey (many tourists take advantage of the almost 2 hours of travel to sleep). This transportation service includes both the outward leg (from the city of Cusco to Ollantaytambo) and the return leg (from Ollantaytambo to the city of Cusco).

EXPEDITION TRAIN TRIP (OPTIONAL VISTADOME)

In Ollantaytambo, tourists board the Expedition tourist train that will take them to the town of Aguas Calientes (1 hour 40 minutes trip). The Expedition train is a service for tourists that offers: comfortable seats, tables, large windows and on-board service selling snacks and drinks. During the trip they will also listen through the loudspeakers to informative announcements of the route that the train follows: a route through beautiful Andean landscapes and even other archaeological sites built by the Incas. Optionally, if the tourist adds an extra cost, he/she can change this service for the Vistadome train. This train offers the same amenities but with complimentary snacks and drinks. On the return leg, it also includes a show of Cusco dances and a parade of clothing made of alpaca, highly recommended!

FINAL TRIP IN ECOLOGICAL BUS

In Aguas Calientes tourists will travel the final stretch to Machu Picchu in a comfortable ecological bus (route of only 30 minutes). The buses are ecological, spacious and comfortable. They offer large windows to observe the beautiful landscapes that are a prelude to Machu Picchu. The final bus trip is a round trip. All tourists have their seats reserved. Sometimes there can be queues before boarding the buses.

MACHU PICCHU ENTRANCE ONLY

The tour includes the ticket Machupicchu Only, the most used by tourists from all over the world to visit the wonder of the Incas. This ticket allows you to visit all the Inca temples and enclosures such as: the Temple of the Sun, the Intihuatana, the Temple of the Condor, the Main Temple, the Sacred Rock and much more. The most important thing is that this ticket allows you to get the classic postcard photo of Machu Picchu that all tourists dream of. The ticket Machu Picchu Only is allowed for people of all ages. The ticket offers discounts for university students, people under 18 years old and citizens of Peru, Colombia, Ecuador and Bolivia. Check the tour discounts and take advantage!

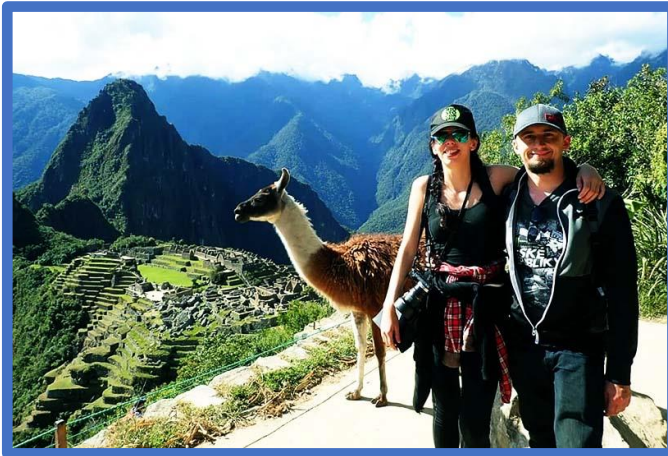
PROFESSIONAL TOURIST GUIDE IN SPANISH OR ENGLISH

The tour includes the service of a professional tour guide on a shared route (the tourist together with other tourists of different origins). The tour with tour guide takes approximately 2 hours. The languages available are Spanish or English. Groups are made up of a maximum of 10 tourists. The guide is a qualified professional with extensive experience. He/she has knowledge of Machu Picchu and Quechua culture (the guides are Quechua speakers). Thanks to the tour guide, the tour of Machu Picchu is complete, more informative and more enjoyable.

LUNCH AT TINKUY RESTAURANT (EXTRA OPTIONAL SERVICE)

The tour does not include lunch. However, tourists have the option to request for an additional payment, the special lunch service at the prestigious restaurant Tinkuy, belonging to the 5 star hotel Sanctuary Lodge (the only hotel in the area located next to the archaeological site of Machu Picchu). This lunch has a promotional cost reserved only for tourists who take the 'Machupicchu Full Day all inclusive' tour. You can request it at the time of the online purchase of the tour. The menu includes appetizers, main courses, dessert and hot drinks. All prepared by the best chefs in Cusco, take advantage of this super promotion!

TOUR MACHU PICCHU FULL DAY – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

DOES THE TOUR HAVE LIMITED AVAILABILITY?

The tour has limited availability. It is best to hire it 2 or 3 weeks in advance.

CAN I CANCEL THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes. The tour can be canceled, as long as it is done in advance (the last period allowed is 3 days before). The request must be sent by email. **The single penalty is 50% of the value of the tour (refund of 50% of the amount paid).** The money is sent by the same method by which the payment was made: Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club, American Express, PayPal.

CAN I CHANGE THE DATE OF THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes, the tour can be modified in names and dates. However, it must be done within a reasonable period of time (last 3 days before). The request is sent by e-mail. **The penalty to be paid is: 40% of the tour value (if the request is sent 3 to 5 days before).** Penalty of 30% of the tour value (if the request is sent 6 to 10 days before). Penalty of 20% of the tour value (if the request is sent 11 days or more in advance).

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE PICK UP FROM MY HOTEL?

Yes, the tour includes pick up from the tourist's hotel located in the historic center of Cusco. Most tourist hotels are in this area. In case your hotel is located outside this area, you should coordinate the pick up in a central square of the city.

WHAT TYPE OF TICKET TO MACHU PICCHU IS INCLUDED?

The tour includes the 'Ticket Machupicchu Only'. This ticket allows you to visit the main constructions of the Inca citadel. It also allows you to get the classic postcard photo with Machu Picchu in the background.

AT WHAT ALTITUDE IS MACHU PICCHU?

Machu Picchu is located at 2,430 meters above sea level. At that altitude it is not common to suffer from the symptoms of altitude sickness.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE LUNCH?

No. The tour does not include lunch. However, the tour offers a special lunch promotion at the prestigious Tinkuy restaurant (belonging to the 5 star hotel Sanctuary Lodge). This hotel is the only one located next to the archaeological site of Machu Picchu.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THE TOUR?

You can pay for the tour online using our payment form. **Payment is by any Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club or PayPal credit or debit card.** The website has internet security systems that guarantee the privacy of the tourists' information. After payment you will receive a confirmation email. The reservation will be confirmed.

WHAT TYPE OF TRAIN TRAVEL IS INCLUDED IN THE TOUR?

The tour includes the Expedition train trip in one way (from Ollantaytambo to Aguas Calientes) and return (from Aguas Calientes to Ollantaytambo). The tour also offers the option to choose (for an additional cost), the Vistadome train service. This service is especially recommended on the return train (includes dance show and parade of clothing made of alpaca).

DOES THE TOUR OFFER DISCOUNTS?

Yes, the tour offers discounts for university students, people under 18 years old and citizens of Peru, Colombia, Ecuador and Bolivia. Prices are promotional and according to the Cusco tourist market.

IS THE TOUR AVAILABLE EVERY DAY?

Yes. The Machu Picchu Full Day tour is available every day of the year, except in cases of exceptional emergencies such as natural disasters or protests on the route. January, February and March are the rainiest months and it is when fewer tourists visit Machu Picchu. The rest of the year the influx of visitors is greater. It is recommended to bring a rain poncho, sunscreen, mosquito repellent. Enjoy your visit!
