CUSCO SOUTH VALLEY TOUR HALF DAY - THE TOUR TO THE ORIGINS OF THE INCAS!

ABSTRACT

Legends say that the Incas came to Cusco from the south. Historical sources confirm these hypotheses. Citadels of great importance were built there, such as Tipón, Raqchi and even the pre-Inca citadel of Piquillacta. Today all these historic places are known in the tourist market as the South Valley of Cusco. The preferred tour for visitors to this Andean area is the so-called 'South Valley Tour of Cusco' for half a day (6 hours) which includes a visit to: the archaeological site of Tipón, the archaeological site of Andahuaylillas and the colonial church of Andahuaylillas. Also during this route you can see the picturesque town of Andahuaylillas and the famous Rumicolca (gateway to the South Valley).


The South Valley tour of Cusco begins at an average of 8 in the morning with the pick up of the tourist at the door of his hotel. In addition to the pick-up, it includes: full round trip transportation, entrance to all tourist attractions and professional tour guide service. The tour ends at an average of 2:30 in the afternoon in a central square in the city of Cusco. CUSCO SOUTH VALLEY TOUR HALF DAY – DETAILED ITINERARY



ITINERARY

1. Pick up from the tourist hotel

The tour begins between 8 and 8:30 in the morning with the pick up of the tourist at the door of his hotel located in the area of the historic center of Cusco. Tourists staying outside this area can expect to be picked up at a central city square, such as Plaza Regocijo (a few steps from Plaza de Armas).

2. Trip and visit to Tipon

Then we head south of Cusco, heading to the archeological site of Tipón. There we will tour some of the best preserved and least known Inca constructions in Peru. Tipón is famous for its water sources and beautiful landscapes.

3. Trip and visit to Piquillacta

Next we will go to Piquillacta, where you can see all the beauty of the South Valley of Cusco, such as the Huacarpay lagoon and the mountain range. In addition, we will visit the Wari archaeological site, famous for its high walls and immense streets. The tour will be, as always, in the company of a professional tour guide.

4. Trip and visit to Andahuaylillas

We continue the tour, visiting the traditional town of Andahuaylillas. There we will visit the Church of San Pedro Apóstol, one of the colonial jewels in Cusco. Due to the beauty of its canvases, murals and its baroque interior decoration, this temple is known as the 'Sistine Chapel of America'.

6. Return to the city of Cusco

We will end the tour returning with the tourist transport to the city of Cusco at an average of 2:30 pm. The service ends in a central city square, a few steps from the main restaurants and hotels. The visit to the South Valley of Cusco is an adventure to the origins of the Incas. Enjoy it!

LANDSCAPES OF THE SOUTH VALLEY OF CUSCO

The South Valley of Cusco offers Andean landscapes of great beauty. The Vilcanota River, the Huacarpay Lagoon as well as the Pachatusan, Huaypun, Pumacancha and more mountains stand out. All these landscapes can be seen in the attractions to visit as well as in tourist transport. If time permits, you can also stop to take a beautiful photo with the most beautiful landscapes.

TIPÓN ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE

The archaeological site of Tipón was an Inca citadel and religious site for the worship of water as an element of purification. It has terraces, platforms, carved stone rooms for the Inca elite, simple stone and adobe rooms for the common population and, above all, water channels. The chronicles indicate that Tipón was the residence of the Inca ruler Yahuar Huacac. It stands out for its Intihuatana, the Cruzmoqo viewpoint and its Andean landscapes. Tipón is the first tourist destination to visit in the South Valley tour of Cusco. It is only 25 kilometers from the city of Cusco.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE OF PIQUILLACTA

The archaeological site of Piquillacta was a pre-Inca citadel, dating from the Wari period, from the end of the 6th century to the beginning of the 9th century. This city had a population of 10 thousand people. The archaeological site was made up of 700 buildings, 500 warehouses (colcas), streets, squares and other stone and adobe buildings. It stands out for its walls two or three stories high. Some of its most important constructions are the Choqepucjio, the Qaranqayniyuj, the Kanturqaqa, the Urpicancha, the Amarupata platforms and the Yunkapunku. Piquillacta means 'Village of Fleas'. This kind of 'ghost town' encompasses approximately 700 structures. It is one of the most photographed tourist attractions in the South Valley of Cusco.

THE RUMICOLCA

The Rumicolca is one of the most famous Inca constructions in the South Valley of Cusco. It is located next to the southeast highway, 31 kilometers from the city of Cusco. It is a pyramidal structure made of stone and adobe that functioned as an entry point to Piquillacta. It is also known as the gateway to the South Valley of Cusco. Each pyramid has three levels reaching 4 meters high. A set of stone steps leads from the base to the top of the building. Your visit is optional in the South Valley tour of Cusco.

TOWN OF ANDAHUAYLILLAS

The town of Andahuaylillas is located 40 kilometers by road from the city of Cusco. It is located on the banks of the Vilcanota River in a warm valley at 3,133 meters above sea level. From there you have beautiful views of the Wiraconchan and Curi Orqo mountains. This peculiar town enjoyed great importance during the colonial era. Powerful families of Inca origin settled there. Its quiet streets and smiling square attract the attention of visitors. However, what stands out most about this place is its colonial church, the temple of San Pedro de Andahuaylillas, also known as the 'Sistine Chapel of America'.

THE SISTINE CHAPEL OF AMERICA

The colonial church of the town of San Pedro de Andahuaylillas is famous for its baroque interior decoration full of murals, paintings, altarpieces, organs and more. Works of art stand out, such as the mural of the evangelizing program, the main altarpiece, the organ of King David and the Queen, the organ of the Angels, the Baptistery, the triumphal arch, the ceiling, and its beautiful canvases. Of the latter, the paintings of the 'Escuela cusqueña' stand out, such as: The Crucifixion, The Virgin of the Rosary and more. This church is the last tourist attraction to visit on the tour to the South Valley of Cusco. Then the return to the city of Cusco is made.

CUSCO SOUTH VALLEY TOUR HALF DAY – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE THE PICK UP FROM MY HOTEL IN CUSCO?

Yes, the tour includes the pick up of the tourist from the door of his hotel in the city of Cusco. The pick-up is available for hotels located in the area comprised by the historic center of Cusco (the vast majority of tourist hotels are located there). Coordination is by email prior to the tour.

CAN I CANCEL THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes, the tour can be canceled and request a refund if an email request is sent up to 3 days in advance as the latest deadline. The cancellation has a penalty of 35% of the value of the tour (refund of 65% of the amount paid).

CAN I CHANGE THE DATE OF THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes, tour modifications can be made with an email request. If the change is made 3 to 5 days in advance, the penalty is 35% of the value of the tour. If it is done from 5 days to more, there is no penalty.

IS THE TOUR DANGEROUS?

No, the tour is safe for all visitors. The places to visit do not show any type of danger. It is only recommended to follow the advice of the tour guide, who is in charge of ensuring the safety of all visitors.

ARE ALL TICKETS ALREADY INCLUDED IN THE TOUR?

Yes, all the tickets are already included in the tour: the entrance to the archeological sites of Tipón, Piquillacta and the colonial temple of Andahuaylillas.

AT WHAT ALTITUDE IS THE SOUTH VALLEY OF CUSCO?

Tipón is located at 3,560 meters above sea level. Piquillacta is 3,250 meters above sea level. Andahuaylillas is 3,122 meters above sea level.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE BREAKFAST OR LUNCH?

No, the tour does not include breakfast or lunch as it lasts only 6 hours (half a day).

HOW DO I PAY FOR THE TOUR?

You can pay for the tour online using our payment form. Payment is by any Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club or PayPal credit or debit card. The website has internet security systems that guarantee the privacy of tourist information. After payment you will receive a confirmation email. The reservation will be confirmed.

IS THE TOUR SUITABLE FOR EVERYONE? CAN I SUFFER FROM ALTITUDE SICKNESS?

Yes. The tour is suitable for all people, both children and older adults. For a better adaptation to the altitude of the South Valley of Cusco, it is recommended to spend one or two previous days in the city of Cusco. In this way, the tourist will be able to better adapt to the Andean geography and reduce the symptoms of altitude sickness.

WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO DO THE TOUR?

The tour to the South Valley of Cusco can be done every day of the year. Most tourists prefer to do it between the months of April to December when the rains are less frequent. In April, November and December excellent photographs are achieved.

IS THE TOUR AVAILABLE EVERY DAY?

Yes, the tour is available all year except in cases of emergency such as protests or natural disasters.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I MISS THE TOUR?

In case the tourist does not show up for the tour at the time indicated for the pick-up, the service will be considered as 'No Show' and the tourist will not have the right to any claim or refund of money.
