


CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK

TOUR CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK 4 DAYS – THE ROUTE TO THE LOST CITY OF THE INCAS!

ABSTRACT

Choquequirao has nothing to envy of Machu Picchu. Its platforms, temples, squares, enclosures and other constructions are as important as the 'Inca city'. The surrounding tropical mountainous landscape also has characteristics akin to the wonder of the world. Even so, few tourists have visited Choquequirao. The reason? There are no roads or train tracks to get there. Currently, the only way to do it is by walking. Most tourists do it through the 4-day Choquequirao trek.

The 4-day Choquequirao trek tour includes everything you need to enjoy a safe and complete adventure: pick-up, transportation, professional guide, entrance fees, camping equipment, food provided by chefs, porters with horses and more. The walk covers 62 kilometers in total. 31 kilometers to go and 31 kilometers to return. This adventure is suitable for all people. Good physical condition is required, although everyone can complete it if they put their mind to it. Enjoy the incredible route to the 'Lost City of the Incas'!

IT INCLUDES:

- ✓ Briefing (summary of the tour by the guide) one night before the tour.
- ✓ Pick up from the tourist hotel in the city of Cusco.
- ✓ Complete round trip transportation (tourist minivan transfer).
- ✓ Team of cooks in camps: 3 breakfasts, 4 lunches and 3 dinners (with vegetarian option).
- ✓ Transportation of camping utensils by porters and horses.
- ✓ 3 nights of camping (tents and mats).
- ✓ Professional tour guide service in Spanish or English.
- ✓ Entrance to Choquequirao.
- ✓ Water, hygiene products, first aid kit and oxygen.

TOUR CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK 4 DAYS – THE DETAILED ITINERARY



DAY 1: CUSCO – CAPULIYOQ – PLAYA ROSALINA

- The tour begins with the pick up of the tourist at the door of his hotel in the historic center of the city of Cusco.
- Then we will travel by tourist transport for just over 4 hours to the town of Capuliyoc.
- In Capuliyoc the trek begins through beautiful Andean landscapes until we arrive at the camp where we will enjoy a delicious lunch prepared by the chefs.
- The route continues to the town of Chiquisca. Then you descend to the sector of La Playa Rosalina. There we will have dinner and spend the night in a camp set up by our porters.

DAY 2: PLAYA ROSALINA – MARAMPATA – CHOQUEQUIRAO

- Early we will have breakfast at the camp. Then it will follow the route uphill for 2 hours on average to the Santa Rosa camp where we will take a break.
- The trek continues uphill for approximately 3 hours until arriving at the Marampata camp where the cooks will have our delicious lunch ready.
- After lunch we will continue the route until we arrive at Choquequirao, the 'Sacred Sister of Machu Picchu'. There we will accommodate the camp and, after dinner, we will spend the night next to the Inca archaeological site.

DAY 3: CHOQUEQUIRAO – SALTO PAJCHAYOC - CHIQUISCA

- After breakfast we will enter the archaeological site of Choquequirao. Along with our tour guide (who will accompany us for the four days) we will visit its famous constructions.
- After a complete tour of Choquequirao we will enjoy a picnic lunch.
- After lunch we start the way back following the same path of the outward leg. At the Pajchayoc waterfall we will stop to rest and enjoy the scenery.
- After a lighter descent we will rest in the Chiquisca camp. There we will have dinner and spend our last night of camping.

DAY 4: CHIQUISCA - CAPULIYOQ – CUSCO

- In the Chiquisca camp we will have breakfast very early.
- Later we will resume the route for 4 hours to the town of Capuliyoc where we will have lunch.
- After lunch there are still two hours of walking on average to reach the town of Cachora. There we will board the bus that will take us back to the city of Cusco.
- The tour ends in a central square in the city of Cusco.

TOUR CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK 4 DAYS – TOURIST SERVICES INCLUDED

TOURIST TRANSPORT IN ROUND TRIP

The tour includes the pick up of the tourist at his hotel located in the historic center of the city of Cusco. It also includes transportation in a tourist minivan to the starting point of the route in Capuliyoq (town of Cachora). During the return section includes tourist transport from Cachora to the city of Cusco. The tour ends in a central square or at the tourist's hotel.

FOOD WITH CHEFS IN CAMPS

The tour includes three breakfasts, four lunches and three dinners. This food is thanks to the preparation of our team of chefs in the different camps. Tourists can request a vegetarian option in advance via email. The food on the route is nutritious and prepared with Andean ingredients from the region. Does not include breakfast on the first day and dinner on the last day.

FIRST AID KIT

The tour includes first aid equipment for a safe walk. The kit includes alcohol, rubs for sore muscles, oxygen, ointments for wounds, and more. The tour guides also have knowledge of first aid if necessary.

TRANSFER OF UTENSILS WITH PORTERS AND HORSES

The tour includes the transfer service of kitchen and camping utensils by means of porters and horses. The muleteer is the right person to lead the animal through the different camps. A horse is also used in emergencies to transport visitors. Tourists have to bring their own backpacks with them. The transfer on horseback is only for the necessary utensils for the adventure.

ENTRANCE TO CHOQUEQUIRAO

The tour includes the entrance ticket to Choquequirao, a ticket that also allows access to the camping area on the outskirts of the archaeological site. This ticket allows you to visit the constructions of this Inca citadel such as: the main square, the houses, the colcas, the sector of the platforms, the Inca cemetery, the kallankas, the ushnus and more.

PROFESSIONAL TOURIST GUIDE IN SPANISH OR ENGLISH

The tour includes the service of a professional tour guide on a shared route (the tourist along with other tourists from different origins). The guide will accompany the visitors during the 4 days of adventure. The languages available are Spanish or English. The groups are made up of a maximum of 10 tourists. For a group of up to 12 people includes an assistant guide. The tourists have knowledge of the Quechua culture (the guides are Quechua speakers). Thanks to the tour guide, the tour of the route and Choquequirao is complete, more informative and more enjoyable.


CAMPS AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED

The tour includes three nights of camping along the different rest points. The first night at the Playa Rosalina camp. The second night in the Choquequirao camp. And the third night in the Chiquisca camp. The camps include tents, mats and shelter. It is recommended to bring a sleeping bag for comfort.

BRIEFING SERVICE ONE DAY BEFORE

One day before the tour, the tour guide will meet with the members of the group in the lobby of a visitors' hotel to provide more details and advice for the 4-day route to Choquequirao. Coordination is by email.

TOUR CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK 4 DAYS – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

DOES THE TOUR HAVE LIMITED AVAILABILITY?

The tour has limited availability. It is best to hire it 2 or 3 weeks in advance.

CAN I CANCEL THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes. The tour can be canceled, as long as it is done in advance (the last period allowed is 3 days before). The request must be sent by email. The single penalty is 35% of the value of the tour (refund of 65% of the amount paid). The transfer of money is by the same method by which the payment was made: Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club, American Express, PayPal.

CAN I CHANGE THE DATE OF THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes. The tour can be modified in names and dates. However, it must be done within a prudent period (last period of 3 days before). The request is sent by email. The penalty that must be paid is: 25% of the value of the tour (if the request is sent 3 to 5 days before). If the request is sent from 5 days to more, there is no penalty.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE PICK UP FROM MY HOTEL?

Yes. The tour includes pick up from the tourist's hotel located in the historic center of Cusco. Most tourist hotels are in this area. In case your hotel is located outside this area, you must coordinate the pick-up in a central square of the city.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE THE ENTRANCE TICKET TO CHOQUEQUIRAO?

Yes, the ticket includes the access ticket to the archaeological site of Choquequirao. This ticket also allows access to the camping area of the archaeological site. The second night of the tour is spent there.

WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM ALTITUDE OF THE TOUR?

The Playa Rosalina viewpoint is 3,000 meters above sea level. At that altitude you can feel some symptoms of altitude sickness: fatigue, migraine, tiredness, etc.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE FOOD?

Yes. The tour includes 3 breakfasts, 4 lunches and 3 dinners. The dishes are prepared by our chef team. Another part is prepared in the chosen tourist restaurants. All foods are nutritious and delicious. Breakfast on the first day and dinner on the last day are not included.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THE TOUR?

You can pay for the tour online using our payment form. Payment is by any Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club or PayPal credit or debit card. The website has internet security systems that guarantee the privacy of tourist information. After payment you will receive a confirmation email. The reservation will be confirmed.

IS THE TOUR DANGEROUS?

No, the Choquequirao trek 4 days tour is challenging but not dangerous. The roads are safe as well as the camps. Of course, it is recommended that older adults are in good health, especially of the heart. Children must like this type of walks.

CAN I DO THE CHOQUEQUIRAO TREK ON A PRIVATE TOUR?

IS THE TOUR AVAILABLE EVERY DAY?

Yes. The Choquequirao trek 4 days tour is available every day of the year, except in cases of exceptional emergencies such as natural disasters or protests on the route. January, February and March are the rainiest months and it is when fewer tourists visit Choquequirao. The rest of the year the influx of visitors is greater. It is recommended to bring a rain poncho, sunscreen, mosquito repellent, comfortable sports clothing, as well as snacks and drinks. Enjoy your visit!
