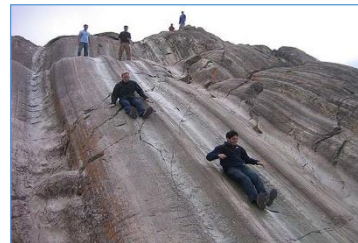

## TOUR CITY TOUR + SACRED VALLEY + MACHU PICCHU 4 DAYS – The DETAILED ITINERARY



### ITINERARY

#### DAY 1:

- The service begins with the pick up of the tourist from the Cusco airport (with previous coordination).
- Then the transfer to the hotel chosen by the visitor is made. There are several hotel options in the city. All 100% recommended for their good service!
- In the afternoon, the half-day City Tour Cusco (from 1:30 pm to 6:30 pm) takes place around the city where we will visit tourist attractions such as: the Coricancha, the Cathedral, Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Pucapucara and Tambomachay.
- At night you will rest in the tourist hotel, the same for the rest of the nights.

#### DAY 2:

- The second day of the tour, after breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for the Sacred Valley of the Incas. The tour lasts 11 hours (from 7 am to 7 pm)
- The first tourist attraction to visit is the Taray viewpoint where you can get incredible photos of the Sacred Valley of the Incas.
- After a 1 hour journey from the city of Cusco we will arrive at the archaeological site of Pisac. Together with our tour guide we will visit the constructions of this citadel and religious site of the Incas. We will know its immense platforms and ceremonial enclosures.
- After the visit to Pisac we will go to the town of Urubamba. There we will make a stop at the famous Tunupa restaurant to enjoy a delicious buffet lunch. This restaurant is one of the best in Cusco. It includes soups, salads, fruits, meats, breads, desserts and the best of Peruvian cuisine.
- After the delicious lunch we will continue with the trip to the archaeological site of Ollantaytambo. There we will visit its temples and megalithic constructions such as: the Temple of the Sun, the Enclosure of the 10 Niches, the Ñusta Baths and more.
- During the return trip we will make a stop in the town of Chinchero to visit its archaeological site and its famous textile centers. In the archaeological center we will observe the colonial church built on the foundations of the palace of Emperor Túpac Yupanqui. Then we will learn the ancient techniques of weaving and dyeing garments made of alpaca. We will also have the option of purchasing alpaca clothing from Chinchero.
- At the time indicated by the tourist we will board the minivan to return to the city of Cusco. The end point is in a central square of the city at around 7 pm.

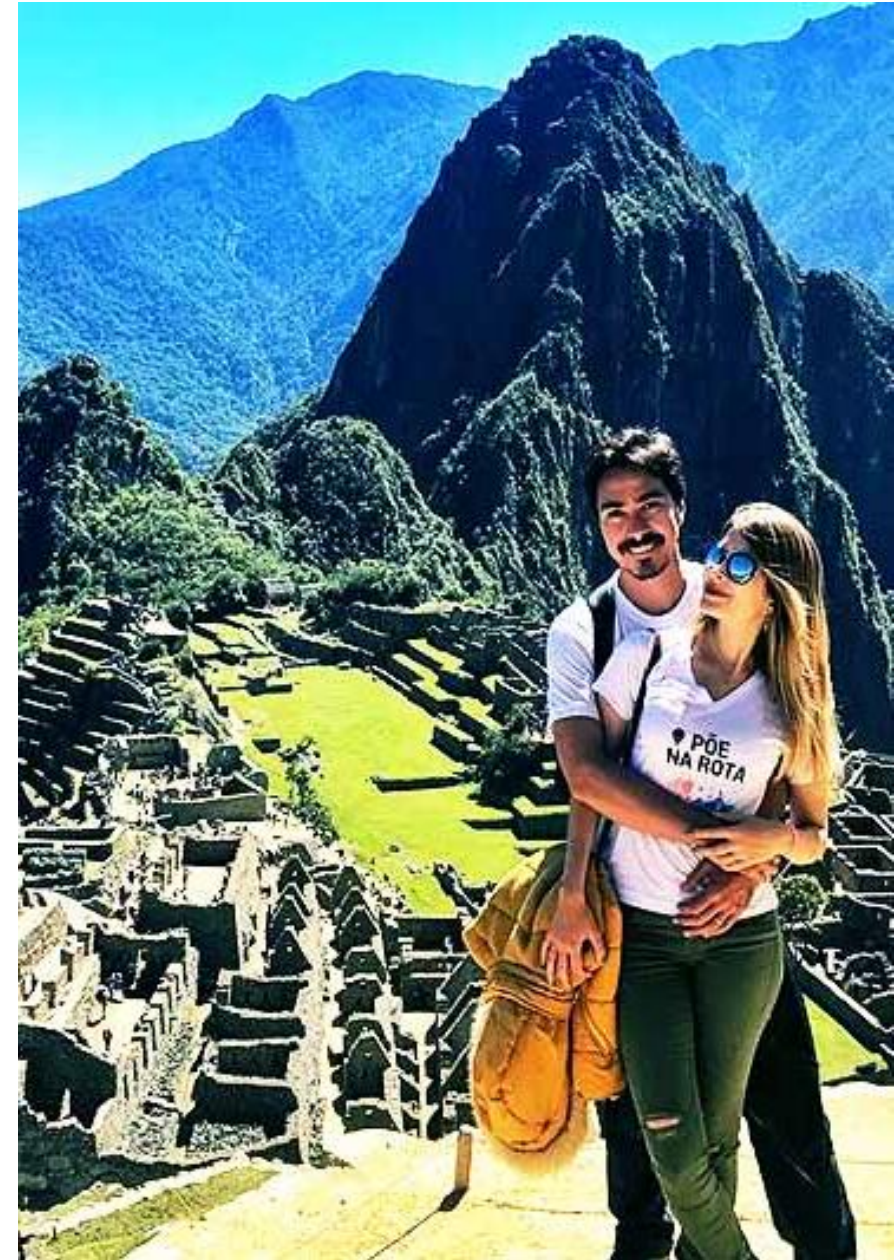
### ITINERARY

#### DAY 3:

- The tour begins with the pick up from the tourist's hotel in the city of Cusco at around 4 am.
- On board a modern minivan, tourists will travel from the city of Cusco to the Ollantaytambo train station in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. This journey takes approximately 1 hour 45 minutes.
- On board the Expedition train, tourists will travel through beautiful Andean landscapes towards the town of Aguas Calientes. This journey takes 1 hour 40 minutes on average. The train offers a pleasant trip surrounded by beautiful landscapes of the Sacred Valley of the Incas.
- In the town of Aguas Calientes a person will accompany you to the bus station where you must board the ecological service that leads to Machu Picchu. The journey is short. It takes only 30 minutes.
- The entrance to Machu Picchu will be in the company of a professional tourist guide. The tour of the archaeological site takes approximately 2 hours. During the visit you can take the classic postcard photo that everyone dreams of. You will also appreciate the main temples and constructions.
- At the end of the visit to Machu Picchu it is time to return by bus to Aguas Calientes. In this town you will have free time for lunch (not included in the tour). If you contracted the special lunch, you will enjoy a delicious menu at the Tinkuy restaurant (belonging to the 5-star Sanctuary Lodge hotel).
- At the time indicated by the tour guide, you must board the Expedition train that will take you back to the town of Ollantaytambo. There an assistant will help you board the minivan in the direction of the city of Cusco. The tour ends at around 8:00 p.m. in a central square in the city of Cusco.

#### DAY 4:

- The fourth and last day of the tour we will have breakfast in the hotel dining room.
- At the time scheduled by the tourist, we will pick you up from your hotel to transfer you to the airport in the city of Cusco.
- There the tour ends.



## TOUR CITY TOUR + SACRED VALLEY + MACHU PICCHU 4 DAYS – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

### DOES THE TOUR HAVE LIMITED AVAILABILITY?

The tour has limited availability. It is best to book it 2 or 3 weeks in advance.

### CAN I CANCEL THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes. The tour can be canceled, as long as it is done in advance (the last period allowed is 3 days before). The request must be submitted by email. The only penalty is 50% of the value of the tour (refund of 50% of the amount paid). The sending of money is by the same method by which the payment was made: Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club, American Express, PayPal.

### CAN I CHANGE THE DATE OF THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes. The tour can be modified in names and dates. However, it must be done within a prudent period (last period of 3 days before). The request is sent by email. The penalty that must be paid is: 40% of the value of the tour (if the request is sent 3 to 5 days before). Penalty of 30% of the value of the tour (if the request is sent from 6 to 10 days before). Penalty of 20% of the value of the tour (if the request is sent from 11 days to more).

### DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE PICK UP FROM THE AIRPORT?

Yes, the tour includes the pick up of the tourist from the airport of the city of Cusco. Then the transfer is made in tourist transport to the visitor's hotel. Coordination is prior by email.

### WHAT TYPE OF TICKET TO MACHU PICCHU IS INCLUDED?

The tour includes the ticket 'Machu Picchu Solo'. This ticket allows you to visit the main buildings of the Inca citadel and get the postcard photo of Machupicchu.

### AT WHAT ALTITUDE ARE CUSCO AND MACHU PICCHU?

The city of Cusco is 3,399 meters above sea level (masl). Machu Picchu is located at 2,430 masl.

### DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE LUNCH?

The tour includes a buffet lunch at the prestigious Tunupa restaurant in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. It also includes a special lunch at the luxurious Tinkuy restaurant in Machu Picchu (belonging to the 5-star Sanctuary Lodge hotel, the only one located next to Machu Picchu).

### HOW DO I PAY FOR THE TOUR?

You can make the payment for the tour online in our payment form. Payment is by any Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club or PayPal credit or debit card. The website has internet security systems that guarantee the privacy of tourist information. After payment you will receive a confirmation email. The reservation will already be confirmed.

### WHAT TYPE OF HOTELS DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?

The tour includes three nights in standard tourist hotels (2 stars) in the city of Cusco. All the hotels are comfortable, clean and 100% recommended. They include cable TV, Wi-Fi internet and buffet breakfast. Optionally the tourist can select 3 or 4 star hotels for an extra cost.

### DOES THE TOUR OFFER DISCOUNTS?

Yes. The tour offers discounts for university students, people under 18 years of age as well as citizens of Peru, Colombia, Ecuador and Bolivia. The prices are promotional and according to the tourist market of Cusco.

### CAN I SUFFER ALTITUDE SICKNESS ON THE TOUR?

The tour takes place in the geography of Cusco, a mountainous region where tourists can suffer from altitude sickness. The first two days are the most difficult because the city of Cusco and the Sacred Valley of the Incas are above 3,000 meters above sea level. The last two days are easier because Machu Picchu is only 2,430 meters above sea level.

## TOUR CITY TOUR + SACRED VALLEY + MACHU PICCHU 4 DAYS – THE TOURIST ATTRACTIONS YOU WILL VISIT

### CUSCO CITY

The city of Cusco was the capital of the Inca empire, the Tahuantinsuyo. It is located at 3,399 meters above sea level. Walking through its streets is like visiting a museum. You can see Inca sites and colonial monuments of great beauty and historical importance. The Cathedral of Cusco, the Inca temple of Coricancha, the fortress of Sacsayhuaman and much more stand out. Cusco radiates a special energy that is difficult to describe. It is one of the best destinations on the planet.

### PISAC

The archaeological site of Pisac is located 1 hour 30 minutes away from the city of Cusco. It is located at 3,300 meters above sea level. It was a citadel, Inca urban and religious center that enjoyed great prominence due to the vast area it covered. There the tourist will be able to appreciate famous constructions such as: the set of platforms, the towers, the Inca cemetery, the K'alla Q'asa, the towers, the Amaru Punku and more. At the foot of the archaeological site is the town of Pisac, famous for its craft market and center where gold and silver crafts are made. The visit in Pisac takes approximately 1 hour.

### OLLANTAYTAMBO

Ollantaytambo is one of the most amazing archaeological sites in Cusco. It is located at 2,792 meters above sea level and almost 60 kilometers by road from the city of Cusco. It was an Inca urban and religious center. It is famous for megalithic constructions such as: La Portada Monumental, La Real Casa del Sol, the Baño de la Ñusta, the Temple of the Sun, the Colcas and its immense platforms. Ollantaytambo also served as a fortress because the Incas and the Spanish clashed there in 1537. Because of this, some buildings in Ollantaytambo were damaged. Even so, this Inca site continues to be one of the most amazing and best preserved in Cusco.

### SACSAYHUAMAN AND CORICANCHA

Sacsayhuaman is one of the most visited tourist attractions in Cusco. It is a fortress made of enormous stones, weighing up to 120 tons, which are joined together with great precision and mastery. How were the Incas able to carve stones of such magnitude with such precision? There are several theories about it. The Coricancha was the most important religious temple in the entire Inca empire. It was destined for the sun god, the most important in the Inca worldview. It has the walls with the finest work of carving and carving. It was adorned with relics of gold, silver and other precious stones. On its foundations, the Dominican order built the Temple and Convent of Santo Domingo.

### QENQO, PUCAPUCARA AND TAMBOMACHAY

Qenqo, Pucapucara and Tambomachay are three of the most famous Inca archaeological sites in the city of Cusco. They are on the outskirts of the city, in the upper part. Qenqo was a temple where offerings were made to the Inca gods. Pucapucara was a military enclosure where the Inca troops rested while he was in the sacred baths of Tambomachay. This Inca site was a temple where water was worshiped as an element of purification.

### MACHU PICCHU

Machu Picchu is the Inca city built around 1450 by order of Emperor Pachacutec. It had a religious, administrative and urban function. After being abandoned and forgotten, it was rediscovered in 1911 by the American explorer Hiram Bingham. Due to its scenic and architectural beauty, it was chosen as one of the 7 wonders of the modern world. It is visited on the second day of the 'Sacred Valley + Machu Picchu' tour. You get there from a short bus ride from the town of Aguas Calientes. It is the most visited tourist destination in Cusco and Peru.
