## ONE WAY TICKET – ROUTE AGUAS CALIENTES – MACHU PICCHU

### ABSTRACT

The trip to Machu Picchu begins with the Cusco – Ollantaytambo route by land transport by minivan or bus. This journey is approximately 60 kilometers. The trip takes 1 hour 40 minutes on average. Then, from Ollantaytambo, the trip is made by train passing through the beautiful landscapes of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. This journey is approximately 40 kilometers. It takes 1 hour 45 minutes on average. It is a pleasant experience on the trip to Machu Picchu.

Finally, we arrive at the town of Aguas Calientes, also called Machupicchu town due to its proximity to the Inca citadel. There you only have to travel 10 kilometers uphill on the slopes of a mountain. Although it is possible to walk, this is very tiring (walk of 2 hours or more). For this reason, the best option, and the one that most tourists choose, is to take the tourist bus to Machu Picchu (only a 30-minute trip).

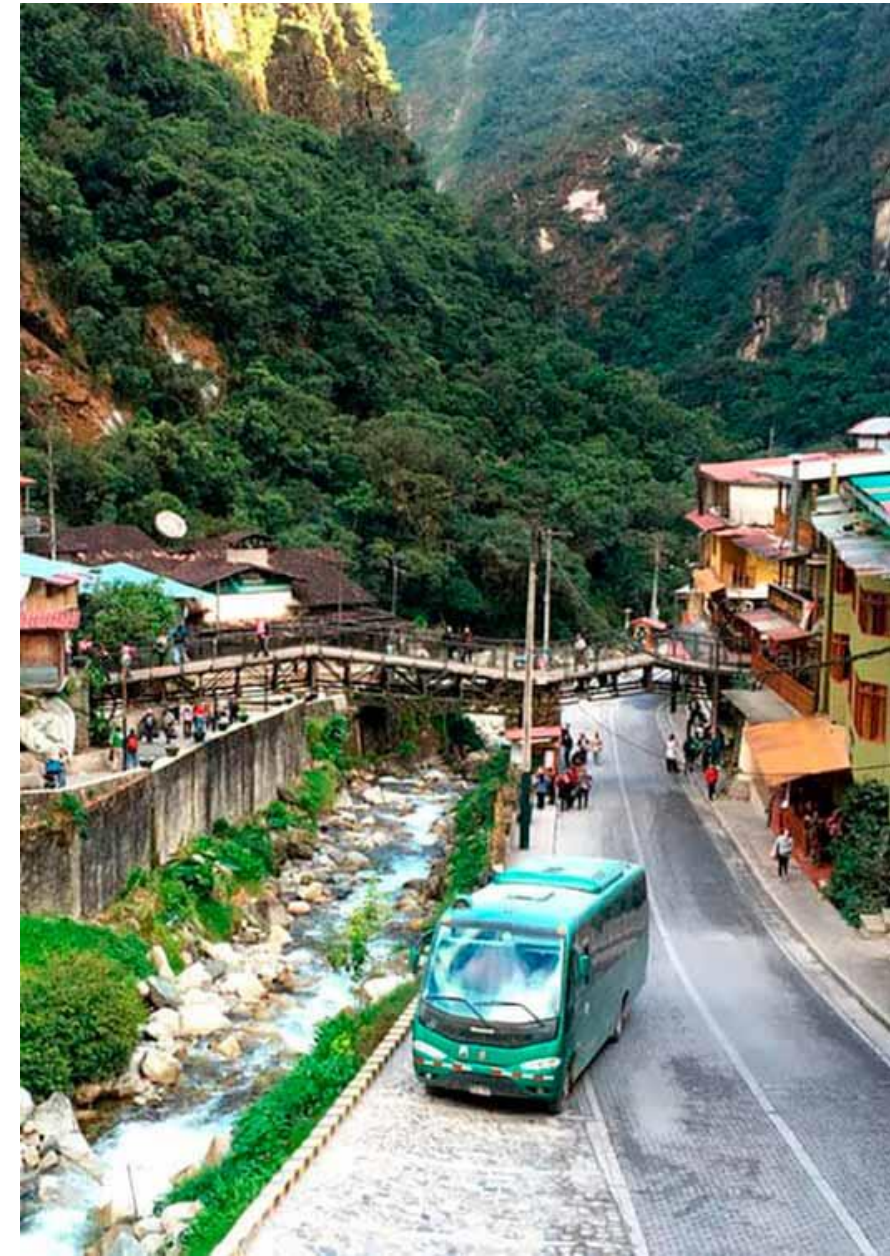
The bus ticket on the uphill section is the most recommended. The reason? Going up to Machu Picchu on foot is very tiring. Tourists will need energy to complete the tourist circuit inside Machu Picchu (walking circuit of almost 2 hours). The bus ticket on the Aguas Calientes – Machu Picchu section allows you to save energy and arrive at Machu Picchu rested. Most tourists choose this option. Recommended!

## RETURN TICKET – ROUTE AGUAS CALIENTES – MACHU PICCHU

### ABSTRACT

After the visit to Machu Picchu, it is time to return to Aguas Calientes and, after that, to the city of Cusco. The Machu Picchu – Aguas Calientes route can be done in two ways: by bus or on foot. The first option is recommended because it allows you to get to the town on time and enjoy lunch or to arrive on time for the train ride. However, the option of walking back to Aguas Calientes is also recommended. The reason? The descent is less physically demanding and allows you to enjoy beautiful scenery and a memorable adventure. It is also recommended!

The bus ride from Machu Picchu to Aguas Calientes takes only 30 minutes. The section on foot, almost 2 hours. The walk follows stone steps surrounded by trees and mountainous landscapes. Plus the route is an adventurous way to save a few bucks. The route follows a path of stone steps down the mountain crossing the Hiram Bingham Highway. This adventure is recommended for young people or people in good physical condition.

Choosing the bus ticket, on the other hand, is recommended for people who do not have a good physical condition, or simply feel tired after the tour of Machu Picchu. Bus tickets can be purchased online or at the exit door of Machu Picchu. The bus ticket can be used the same day of the visit to Machu Picchu, one day before or one day after. Includes discounts. Take advantage of!

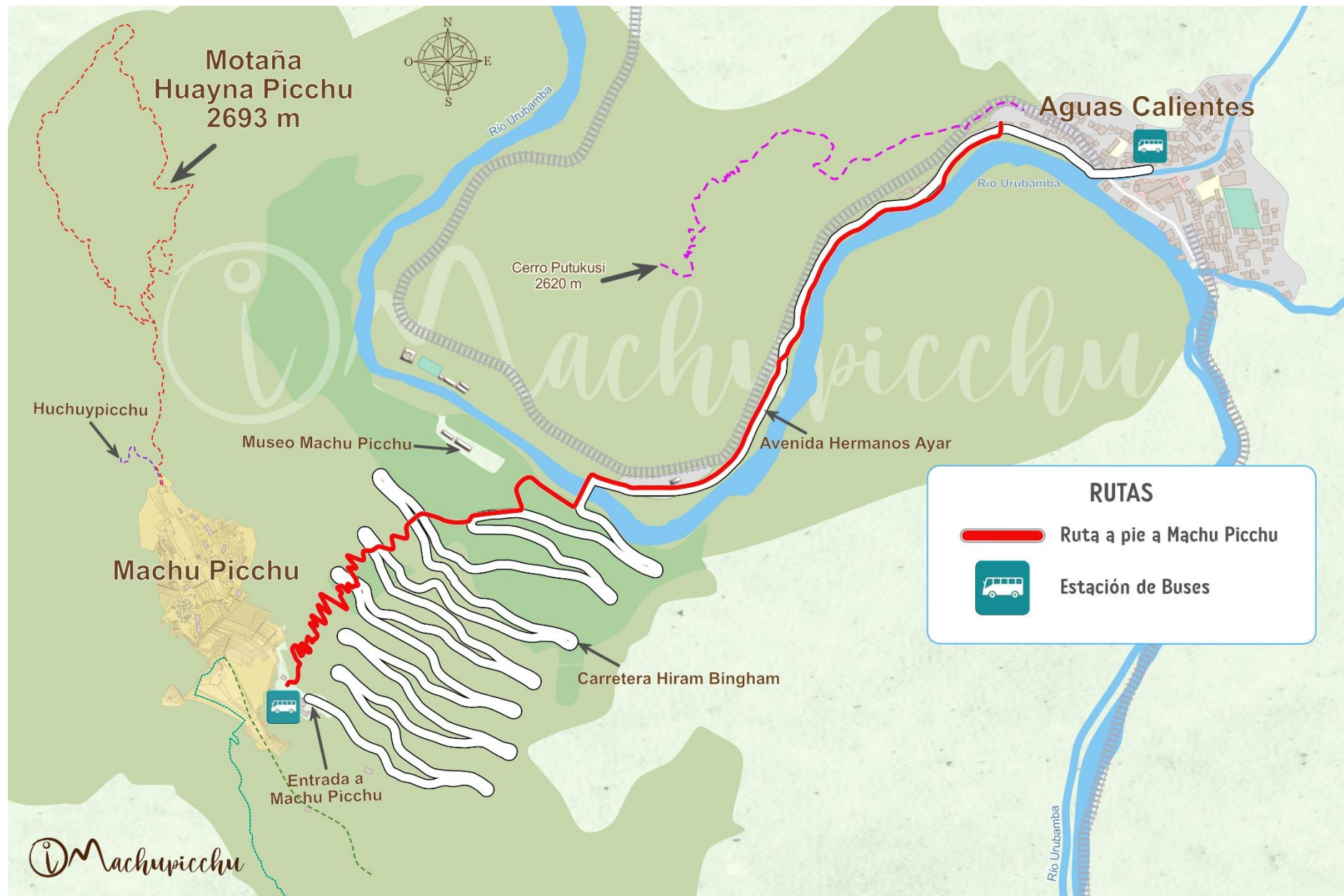


## BUS ROUTE MAP AGUAS CALIENTES – MACHU PICCHU – AGUAS CALIENTES

## TICKETS AND CIRCUITS IN MACHU PICCHU – QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

### WHERE DO YOU TAKE THE BUS TO MACHU PICCHU?

The bus station is located a few meters from the train station. In the Avenue. Ayar Brothers S/N. Since the town of Aguas Calientes is very small, you can easily find your way around it. For the return section, the bus is taken at the entrance gate of Machu Picchu.

### CAN I SHOW THE TICKET IN DIGITAL FORMAT?

Yes, the ticket can be shown both in digital format and in physical format. It is recommended to take a screenshot of the ticket and also get a photocopy of it.

### WHAT IS THE BUS DEPARTURE TIME?

The buses leave Aguas Calientes from 5:30 in the morning (Machu Picchu opens its doors at 6 in the morning). The last bus leaves Aguas Calientes at 3:30 p.m. The last return bus from Machu Picchu to Aguas Calientes leaves at 5:30 p.m. The buses leave every day of the year.

### CAN I VISIT MACHU PICCHU WITHOUT THE BUS TICKET?

Yes, the bus ticket is not essential to visit Machu Picchu. Instead of doing the route by bus, you can go from Aguas Calientes to Machu Picchu on foot. The walk takes approximately 2 hours. It is recommended for people in good physical condition. In the case of the return section, you can also take the bus or descend on foot. The return section takes 1 hour 30 minutes and is easier because the route is descending through stone steps.

### DOES THE BUS TICKET INCLUDE ENTRANCE TO MACHU PICCHU?

No, the entrance to Machu Picchu is not included in the bus ticket. This ticket can be purchased online through the official sales website or on the website of a tourism agency. The bus ticket does not include an official tourist guide or a train ticket or any additional service in addition to the bus trip on the Aguas Calientes – Machu Picchu – Aguas Calientes route.

### CAN I BUY BUS TICKETS IN MACHU PICCHU?

Yes, bus tickets are widely available so they can be purchased both online and in person in the same town of Aguas Calientes or at the entrance gate of Machu Picchu.

### DO CHILDREN TRAVEL FREE ON THE BUS TO MACHU PICCHU?

All children under 5 years of age can travel for free on the bus as long as they do so on the knees of their father or mother (they do not occupy seats). Children under 11 years of age have discounts on the bus ticket. Those over 12 years old already pay as adult tourists. All tourists must show their passport or identity document when boarding the bus.

### ARE THERE QUEUES TO TAKE THE BUS TO MACHU PICCHU?

In the early hours of the morning, especially in the months of high tourist activity (May, June, July and August), long queues tend to form to board the bus to Machu Picchu. These queues usually take between 10 to 15 minutes approximately. From 9 or 10 in the morning, these queues decrease.

### IS THE BUS TRIP SAFE?

Yes, the trip is safe. The route is short and follows the 'Hiram Bingham' road. Only the buses that take tourists to Machu Picchu pass through there. The ride includes comfortable seats and large windows. All drivers are trained professionals and constantly evaluated by the authorities of Machu Picchu.

### HOW TO BUY THE BUS TICKET ONLINE?

The bus ticket can be purchased online through 'boletomachupicchu.com'. You just have to click on 'Book' and fill in the visitor's personal data. The purchase is online through Visa, MasterCard, Diners Club, American Express or PayPal credit or debit cards. Once the payment has been made, the visitor will receive a confirmation email with the bus ticket in PDF format. You only have to show it (printed or digital) for the day of the visit to Machu Picchu.
