In addition, there is a visit to the thermal baths of Aguas Calientes, considered the best in all of Cusco. As if that were not enough, the last day of the tour takes place a tourist visit to Machu Picchu, one of the 7 wonders of the world. The entire tour is carried out within an all-inclusive service that offers: pick up from the hotel, professional guide, necessary equipment for the practice of each sport, 3 nights in tourist hotels on the route, food in tourist restaurants, entrance to Machu Picchu and return to Cusco by train. The service is organized by 'Machupicchu Terra', one of the best tourist agencies in Cuzco. Enjoy Machupicchu as you dreamed of it!

INCA JUNGLE TOUR 4 DAYS – THE DETAILED ITINERARY

ITINERARY

DAY 1:

- The Inca Jungle tour begins with the pick up from the tourist's hotel in the city of Cusco.
- Immediately we make the trip in tourist transport through the Sacred Valley of the Incas. In Ollantaytambo we stop for a few minutes to make last-minute purchases.
- Then we will continue in the tourist transport (total trip of almost 3 hours) until arriving at the Malaga pass, located at 4,200 meters above sea level. From there you have a beautiful view of the high mountains and snow-capped peaks of Cusco.
- At the Málaga pass we will unload the bicycles for a short preparation. The bicycle route is almost 2 hours through tracks surrounded by mountains and the geography of the high jungle of Cusco. It also includes a visit to the archaeological site of Huamanmarca, always in the company of our professional tour guide.
- In the afternoon we will have lunch in a tourist restaurant in the town of Santa María. That afternoon we will do the canoeing adventure on the waters of the Vilcanota River.
- At night we will rest in a tourist hotel in the town of Santa María, in the middle of the jungle of Cusco (1,204 meters above sea level).

DAY 2:

- The second day begins at approximately 6 in the morning. After a delicious breakfast we will start a walk surrounded by incredible landscapes.
- We will cross a section of the Inca trails (the qhapac ñan) which was part of the route that connects Machu Picchu with the Inca citadel of Vilcabamba.
- In the town of Quellomayo we will stop for lunch at a local tourist restaurant.
- For 3 more hours the hiking route continues surrounded by landscapes of the Cusco jungle. At sunset we will arrive at the thermal baths of Cocalmayo, one of the most paradisiacal in Cusco (admission ticket not included at 10 Peruvian soles).
- After enjoying the thermal baths of Cocalmayo we will return by tourist transport to the town of Santa Teresa (1,550 meters above sea level). There, we will have a nice dinner in a tourist restaurant. Finally we will rest in a tourist hotel in the town..



DAY 3:

- The third day begins at 6 am with a nutritious breakfast in the town of Santa Teresa.
- Then we will travel by tourist transport to a recreational center in Santa Teresa to practice zip lines. This sport is safe as it is carried out with all the required equipment.
- Then we will continue the trip to the famous Hydroelectric station. There we will enjoy lunch in a tourist restaurant. Next, we will undertake the walk of only 2 kilometers (almost 2 hours) to Machupicchu town.
- We will arrive at Aguas Calientes at around 5 pm. There we will go to the tourist hotel of the town. Then we will have dinner at a tourist restaurant in this magical town.
- Then we will have the afternoon free (an excellent option is to visit the thermal baths).
- At night we will rest in a tourist hotel in Aguas Calientes.

DAY 4:

- Day 4 begins very early (averaging 4.30 in the morning) to enjoy breakfast at the tourist hotel (optional requesting a box breakfast).
- At that time we will begin the walk (approximately 2 hours) uphill towards the entrance gate of Machu Picchu. Optionally, the tourist can avoid this walk by buying a bus ticket in the town of Aguas Calientes.
- We will enter Machu Picchu at approximately 7 am. The tour is accompanied by a professional tour guide and includes a visit to famous buildings such as: the Main Temple, the Temple of the 3 Windows, the Intihuatana, the Temple of the Sun, the Sacred Rock, the Water Mirrors, the Temple of the condor etc It also includes the classic postcard photo in Machupicchu!
- At midday we will return by bus (if included) to the town of Aguas Calientes. The trip takes only 30 minutes. Optionally (for an extra payment) the visitor can have lunch next to Machu Picchu in the Tinkuy buffet restaurant (of the 5-star Sanctuary Lodge hotel).
- Back in the town of Aguas Calientes the tourist will have time to have lunch (not included in the tour) and walk through the magical streets of the town. At the time indicated by the tour guide (approximately 4:20 pm) we will pick up our things from the hotel and go to the Aguas Calientes train station (go 30 minutes before departure time).
- Then, we will board the Expedition tourist train to return to the town of Ollantaytambo for a 1 hour 40 minute ride (optional Vistadome train ride for an extra cost). In Ollantaytambo we will change by bus (1 hour 45 minute trip) until we arrive in the city of Cusco (Wanchaq station).
- At the Wanchaq station, a tourist transport will wait for us to finally take us to our hotel at around 9:00 p.m.



INCA JUNGLE TOUR 4 DAYS - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

IS THERE LIMITED AVAILABILITY FOR THE TOUR?

Unlike other tours such as the 4-day Inca Trail, the 4-day Inca Jungle tour has wide availability. It is recommended to buy the tour 2 or 3 weeks in advance.

CAN I CANCEL THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes, the Inca Jungle 4 days tour can be canceled by paying a penalty equivalent to 50% of the value of the tour (refund of 50% of the amount paid). To do this, a request must be sent by email to info@machupicchuterra.com. The last term to request cancellation is 3 days before the day of the tour.

CAN I CHANGE THE DATE OF THE TOUR IF I ALREADY PURCHASED IT?

Yes, you can change the date of the Inca Jungle tour to Machu Picchu 4 days by paying a penalty that varies according to the advance time with which you make the request. This must be sent to info@machupicchuterra.com. The last term to request the change of date is 3 days before the day of the tour.

IS THE TOUR DIFFICULT? WHO CAN DO IT?

The Inca Jungle is an adventure tour of moderate difficulty. The tour includes the practice of sports such as cycling, canoeing, ziplining and trekking. This adventure is recommended for tourists from 12 years of age and up. Seniors must be in good physical condition.

WHAT TYPE OF TICKET TO MACHU PICCHU IS INCLUDED?

The tour includes the entrance 'Machu Picchu Solo'. This ticket allows you to visit the main constructions of the Inca citadel. In addition, it allows you to get the classic postcard photo with Machu Picchu in the background.

IS THE TOUR AVAILABLE EVERY DAY OF THE YEAR?

Yes, the tour is available every day of the year, except in exceptional cases of strikes or natural disasters that do not allow the normal development of the service.

AT WHAT MAXIMUM ALTITUDE DOES THE TOUR TAKE PLACE?

The first day of the tour you will reach the highest point: the Málaga pass. This pass of the Andes Mountains is located at 4,330 meters above sea level. The lowest point is in the town of Santa Teresa: at 1,550 meters.

DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE FOOD?

Yes. The tour includes 3 breakfasts, 3 lunches and 3 dinners. All these foods are prepared in tourist restaurants on the route. It includes delicious dishes of Peruvian gastronomy. The tour does not include breakfast on day 1 or lunch and dinner on day 4.

HOW DO I PAY FOR THE TOUR?

You can make the payment for the tour online in our payment form. Payment is by any Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Diners Club or PayPal credit or debit card. The website has internet security systems that guarantee the privacy of tourist information. After payment you will receive a confirmation email. The reservation will already be confirmed.

WHAT ADVENTURE SPORTS DOES THE TOUR INCLUDE?

The tour includes cycling on day 1, canoeing on day 1, ziplining on day 3, as well as trekking every day of the tour. All sports are carried out with the necessary safety equipment for a safe adventure. On day 2 in the afternoon there is a visit to the thermal baths of Aguas Calientes, an opportunity to relax.

IS IT DANGEROUS TO DO THE INCA JUNGLE TOUR??

No, the 4-day Inca Jungle to Machu Picchu is organized by 'Machupicchu Terra', a reliable tourism agency. All sports include safety equipment that guarantees the health of visitors. It is worth mentioning that from January to March it rains more frequently throughout Cusco. Therefore, rockfalls may occur. For greater security, it is recommended to take the tour from April to December.

INCA JUNGLE TOUR 4 DAYS – THE TOURIST ATTRACTIONS YOU WILL VISIT

ABRA MÁLAGA

The Málaga pass is the highest pass on the Inca Jungle tour. You get there by bus after a road trip of approximately 3 hours. It has a maximum altitude of 4,330 meters above sea level. It is located on the limits of the high Andean region and the high jungle of Cusco. From there you have a landscape view of the snowy Verónica, one of the highest in the region (5,893 meters above sea level). The Málaga pass is famous because from there the bicycle adventure begins to the Cusco jungle. It is recommended to bring a camera to capture the beautiful landscapes of this pass.

THE JUNGLE OF CUSCO

The 4-day Inca Jungle tour covers the most beautiful landscapes of the Cusco jungle. From the first day the tourist will be able to appreciate plant plantations, pineapples, coffee, cocoa, peaches, apples and more. These landscapes belong to the province of La Convención. The average altitude is 2 thousand meters above sea level. In addition to the natural landscapes on the route, mosquitoes abound, so it is recommended to bring repellent. The rains are more copious and intense (especially from November to March). Therefore it is necessary to bring a poncho for rain. The temperature in the jungle of Cusco varies from 14°C. up to 24°C. on average. It is recommended to also bring a camera and comfortable clothes.

THERMAL BATHS OF COCALMAYO

The Cocalmayo thermal baths are considered the best in all of Cusco. It is located in the town of Santa Teresa, at an altitude of 1,550 meters above sea level. A few steps away is the Vilcanota river. The place has three pools of different sizes and temperatures. These vary from 38°C. up to 44°C. Its waters are clear, turquoise and surrounded by a beautiful environment of tropical mountains. The waters come from a natural spring in the Uripata lagoon. The entrance ticket costs 10 soles for foreign tourists, 5 soles for Peruvian tourists and 2.50 soles for people from Cusco. Hours of operation are from 5 a.m. to 10 p.m.

AGUAS CALIENTES TOWN

Aguas Calientes is also called Machupicchu town due to its proximity to the Inca citadel (they are only 30 minutes away by bus). This magical town is located at 2,040 meters above sea level. It is surrounded by high green mountains. Hundreds of tourists arrive there every day. That is why there are dozens of hotels, restaurants, bars, cafes and other tourist services. What stands out the most about the town are its thermal baths. It is also famous for its beautiful craft market. In Aguas Calientes is the station with the trains that arrive and leave for Cusco. It is a magical place, the perfect prelude to visiting Machu Picchu.

MACHU PICCHU

Machu Picchu is the Inca city built around 1450 by order of Emperor Pachacutec. It had a religious, administrative and urban function. After being abandoned and forgotten, it was rediscovered in 1911 by the American explorer Hiram Bingham. Due to its scenic and architectural beauty, it was chosen as one of the 7 wonders of the modern world. It is the last destination to visit on the 4-day Inca Jungle tour. It is famous for constructions such as the Temple of the Sun, the Main Temple, the Temple of the 3 Windows, the Sacred Rock, the Intihuatana, the Temple of the Condor and more.

NETWORK OF INCAS TRAILS QHAPAC ÑAN

The qhapac ñan were the network of Inca roads that the Incas built along more than 30 thousand kilometers. They covered coastal, mountainous and high jungle areas in the current regions of Peru, Bolivia, Ecuador, Colombia, Argentina and Chile. Due to its historical importance, it was declared by Unesco as a 'Cultural Heritage of Humanity'. A small part of this immense road network is traveled during the Inca Jungle 4 days to Machu Picchu. The only way to do this route It is the same paths that the Incas traveled hundreds of years ago. A historical experience!
